Croesawodd y Cadeirydd Ian Thomas a Howard Waters o Adran Briffyrrdd y Cyngor Sir a diolchodd iddynt am eu presenoldeb. Trefnwyd y cyfarfod i edrych ar y materion sy'n cael eu profi yn Llandyfaelog mewn perthynas â llifogydd yn y pentref.

Nododd Ian Thomas allai ei adran edrych ar faterion cynnal a chadw cyffredinol yn unig ac y byddai angen i'r Tîm Llifogydd wneud unrhyw waith prosiect mwy helaeth. Bydd y Clerc felly yn cysylltu gyda'r adran mewn perthynas â'u hymchwiliadau ar y mater.

Ystyriwyd y cwteri ochr ffordd gyda gwelliannau posibl yn cael eu nodi fel a ganlyn:

- Gwter draen ychwanegol ar ben bryn Llandyfaelog ar hyd yr A484;
- Adleoli draeniau ychydig uwchlaw ac islaw Coedbach;
- Ymestyn gwter draen uwchben y Rose and Crown ynghyd ag ystyried codi ymyl y ffordd i geisio ailgyfeirio dŵr yn rhedeg ar yr heol i ffwrdd o'r eiddo yn dilyn digwyddiadau llifogydd diweddar.

Codwyd mater cerrig rhydd ym Maesdolau a Lon yr Ysgol yn Idole hefyd a chadarnhawyd bod gwaith pellach yn cael ei wneud yn yr ardal i leddfu'r mater.

Notes of site visit, Llandyfaelog

Present: Cllrs Elfyn Williams, Mair Stephens, Philip Davies, Shan Rees, Arfon Davies (Clerk), Ian Thomas and Howard Waters (Carmarthenshire County Council).

The Chairman welcomed Ian Thomas and Howard Waters from the County Council Highways Department and thanked them for their attendance. The meeting had been arranged to look at the issues being experienced in Llandyfaelog in relation to flooding in the village.

Ian Thomas noted that his department could only look at general maintenance issues and that any more extensive project work would need to be carried out by the Flooding Team. The Clerk will therefore chase the department in relation to their investigations on the matter.

Consideration was given to the road side gutters with possible improvements noted as follows:

- An additional drain gutter at the top of Llandyfaelog Hill along the A484;
- Slight relocation of drains above and below Coedbach;
- Extend drain gutter above Rose and Crown along with consideration of raising the verge of the road to try to re-direct running water away from the property following recent flooding incidents.

The issue of loose chippings at Maesdolau and Lon yr Ysgol in Idole was also raised with further work confirmed to be undertaken in the area to alleviate the issue.
