

Message from PCSO Martin Dickenson regarding Dog Thefts

The recent spate of thefts in Carms and Pembs have resulted in a large number of dogs being recovered and returned to their rightful owners. Several arrests have been made and the investigation is ongoing.

A theft on Wednesday 3rd February has resulted in 5 stolen dogs being recovered and at least 1 arrest, again the investigation is ongoing.

Our advice still remains the same, stay vigilant, report suspicious activity on 101 and try to keep everything secure, locked and safe.

CCTV is also a great help in the detection of crime as it gives 24 hr coverage and can sometimes give vital information in the event of a theft.

In 1 of the crimes the victim stated that a suspicious vehicle attended at his remote farm, a few days before the theft of his dogs, he stored the reg of the vehicle and upon Police investigation this vehicle was involved.
