There was an evening to remember, full of fun and laughter, in the company of Nanette's Clothing Shop, Kidwelly and Calon Mam, Llanpumsaint. Thanks to Nanette and Helen for staging the evening, and for giving vouchers for the raffle.

Everyone was welcomed to the hall with a glass of fizz and a selection of homemade desserts. There was then an opportunity for everyone to sit back, and enjoy the evening which was opened by the young people of the area modeling Eisteddfod 2023 T-shirts, hoodies and zudis.

It was Calon Mam's turn to take the stage next, and in their first ever fashion show, a beautiful collection of leisure clothes was shown for the whole family. It was nice to see so many original designs in Welsh, and to see the choices of all shapes and sizes for personalizing clothes, accessories and goods for the home.

Menna James, Cwmffrwd was the President of the Night, and the Committee would like to thank her for her donation to the appeal coffers. She gave a purposeful and entertaining address remembering the stories and troubles of the past; and identified the opportunities and experiences that our local and national institutions alike offer to our young people today.

After a short break, the evening continued with a memorable show by Siop Nanette. Nanette brought twelve models with her, all of whom had been in the shop choosing

dresses and accessories to model. Over fifty different "outfits" were shown, from leisure clothes to formal clothes, coats and accessories for every occasion.

Over £500 was raised, which means that the Committee have now reached their target of raising £6,000. Special thanks to the members of the Committee, chaired by Carys Thomas, for their work, and to Llandyfaelog Community Council, and the whole community for their support for the Urdd.

As Mair had passed away in January this year, Rhiannon Roberts, chair of the committee, presented a tribute to her noting her contribution to her community and county.

The Eisteddfod Chair was won by Terwyn Tomos, Llandudoch with a poem on the subject "Môr". The beautiful chair was donated by Graham and Shân Rees and the family, Cartref, Llandyfaelog. The Young Trophy was won by Gruffudd ab Owain, Bala. The trophy and the cash prize were donated by Huw John, Peniel.

The John and Nan Anderson, Trelimsey Memorial Cup was presented to Ioan Jones, Ysgol Gwenllian for being the local under 11 competitor who shows the most promise. Scholarships were presented. Ron and Mrs. Betty Rees for the best competitor locally under the age of 16 to Harri Jones, Ysgol Bro Myrddin (music) and to Ioan Jones, Ysgol Gwenllian (speech). A challenge cup was presented to the local school with the highest marks to Ysgol Llangynnwr.
