

**MINUTES OF LLANDYFAELOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING  
HELD ON 8 JANUARY 2026 AT 7.30PM**

**2. Declarations of Interest**

No declarations.

**3. Public Participation**

It was noted that no Members of the public were in attendance on this occasion.

**4. Minutes of the meetings of Council held on the 4<sup>th</sup> December 2025 were confirmed and signed.**

**5. Matters Arising**

1. **Green Gen** – Confirmation was again received that the two projects' statutory consultations would take place during 2026. Noted.
2. **Planning application, PL/02147 in property in woodland area – Idole to Pentrepoeth** – Council awaited further updates on the matter. Noted.
3. **Road safety issues at Bancycapel** – Confirmation was received that the statutory consultation has been completed, and support has been received from the Police, Local Members, and the Community Council for the no-overtaking zone. The County Council will now liaise with their Legal Team to arrange publication of the Traffic Regulation Order, which will provide an opportunity for the public to comment in the coming weeks. The Community Council would be notified and provided with a copy of the notice once it had been issued. Noted.
4. **Pont Rhydyronnen** – Confirmation was received that a review of the existing warning signage was underway. Replacement signs or upgrades would be installed in due course. Noted.
5. **PL/09369 - 1-3 Gelligaeros Trading Estate, Cwmffrwd, Carmarthen, SA32 8DJ** – Council awaited further updates on the matter. Noted.
6. **Maesglasnant, Cwmffrwd** – Council awaited further updates on the matter. Noted.
7. **Teifi/Tywi link Community Councils – Meeting for Community and Town Councils in areas impacted by the pylon project** – Minutes of the meeting held on the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025 had been circulated. Noted.

9. **Road Safety at Llandyfaelog Junction** – The County Council had confirmed that they were considering the installation of an additional warning sign to highlight the risk of pedestrians crossing, positioned closer to the junction when travelling from Carmarthen. This would be subject to sufficient verge

width to allow the required minimum clearances from the carriageway edge. Noted.

- 10. Wales Regional Energy Strategic Plans** – The Consultation on the Wales Regional Energy Strategic Plan Methodology was considered.
- 11. National Grid – Llandyfaelog Sub-Station** – The Council had met with the National Grid to discuss the Pre-Application Consultation on the 15<sup>th</sup> December 2025 with a response developed and provided for consideration.
- 12. A484 Cwmffrwd, near Bolahaul Road Junction** - Additional repeater signs and carriageway roundel markings had been installed within the 30mph limit to further reinforce the speed restriction along this section. Noted.
- 13. Ysgol Bro Myrddin – Parking Restrictions** – Cllr Meinir James noted that she had received a dispensation to speak and make representations but not vote on matters relating to Ysgol Gyfun Bro Myrddin. The County Council had noted that since the implementation of the new parking restrictions in the vicinity of the school, no negative feedback has been received. They therefore consider the measures to have improved the management of through traffic past the school. Noted.
