

**MINUTES OF LLANDYFAELOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING  
HELD ON 2 APRIL 2026 AT 7.30PM**

**2. Declarations of Interest**

No declarations.

**3. Public Participation**

It was noted that no Members of the public were in attendance on this occasion.

**4. Minutes of the meetings of Council held on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026 were confirmed and signed.**

**5. Matters Arising**

1. **Green Gen** – Updates were received on the project plan. Noted.
2. **Planning application, PL/02147 in property in woodland area – Idole to Pentrepoeth** – Council awaited further updates on the matter. Noted.
3. **Road safety issues at Bancycapel** – The County Council had confirmed that a new TRO was due to be published in April. Noted.
4. **Pont Rhydyronnen** – The County Council had confirmed that new signage had been ordered with delivery awaited. Noted.
5. **PL/09369 - 1-3 Gelligaeros Trading Estate, Cwmffrwd, Carmarthen, SA32 8DJ** – Council awaited further updates on the matter. Noted.

**1. Tree Survey Works**

Completion of works by Lampeter Tree Services was awaited.

**2. Defibrillators**

The 2 pads required for the defibrillators at Glanmorlais and Croesyceiliog had been purchased and the cost of £250.00, with £10.00 delivery and £52.00 VAT from Defib Store was approved.

A further pad was required for the Constant Farm Defib, this was approved. The cost of £125.00, with £10.00 delivery and £27.00 VAT from Defib Store was approved.

## **8. Community Handyperson**

The Clerk confirmed 28 hours worked in March with a cost of £644.00 agreed.

## **9. St Anne's Church, Cwmffrwd**

Concern was noted that there was a possibility that the Church would be closing. Further concern was expressed in relation to the facilities of the Church Hall. Further enquiries will be made on the matter.

## **10. 2025-26 Budget Report**

The Clerk presented the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter budget report for the 2025-26 Financial Year. Council carried out the quarterly budget monitoring and accepted the report. The Chair carried out a review of the Council financial records.

## **11. 2026-27 Risk Analysis**

Council considered the draft 2026-27 Risk Analysis which was presented by the Clerk. The draft document was agreed.

## **12. 2026-27 Staff Salary and Contracts payment report**

Council agreed to exclude the public and press from the meeting for this item due to the nature of the information to be discussed.

The Clerk presented the information report and the following items were agreed.

### **a) Bus Shelter Cleaners**

Following discussion, it was agreed to set the payment for the Croesyceiliog Bus Shelter at £100 for the year.

### **b) Handyperson**

Handyperson was noted as Michael Leefe with a payment of £24.00 per hour agreed for the year.

### **c) Council Clerk**

It was agreed to retain the current pay point at the top of the relevant scale at point 23, currently £9,306.49. Council confirmed payment of a £26.00 allowance per month for home working. This encompassed the HMRC home working allowance (currently £26.00 per month).

Council further confirmed payment of necessary mileage claims paid on the HMRC mileage allowance rate (currently 45p per mile)

Council discussed possible Community Events in 2026 as follows:

- Community Effort Competition – To be considered further.

Judge details were agreed with the Clerk to contact the possible judge. Further details will be discussed at the next Council meeting.
