The Chairman welcomed representative of National Grid Electricity Distribution (NGED) who had asked to meet with the Community Council to discuss proposals for a 132 kV substation near Llandyfaelog. The location of the substation was within the overall site currently being considered under Planning Application PL/10552 for the erection of a 400kV AIS substation. It was stressed that while this was the case, this application process was entirely separate.

NGED representatives provided details on the background and reasoning for the proposed project and confirmed that following the consultation sessions undertaken in January, that they were now almost ready for the Pre-Application Consultation which was planned to be submitted in May. Thereafter it was anticipated that the full planning application would be submitted to Carmarthenshire County Council in the Summer / Autumn of 2026.

Draft location and site plans were provided and discussed.

An opportunity was provided to members to ask a number of questions on the project.

The Chairman thanked the representatives for their detailed presentation and openness to answer members questions.
